Master Plan Update Timeline




- Begin Master Plan Update in 4th Quarter 2019



Phase 1: Goals

- Facilitate a community visioning process.
- Identify & affirm the Master Plan's Guiding Principles.

This is an update to the Master Plan, not starting from scratch.

We will use the 2010 Master Plan as a starting point and engage with the community to identify areas that need updates, clarification, and revision.



• Build an understanding of the importance of master planning.

November: Guiding Principles & Phase 2 Focus Areas
